- skills development of the working age population

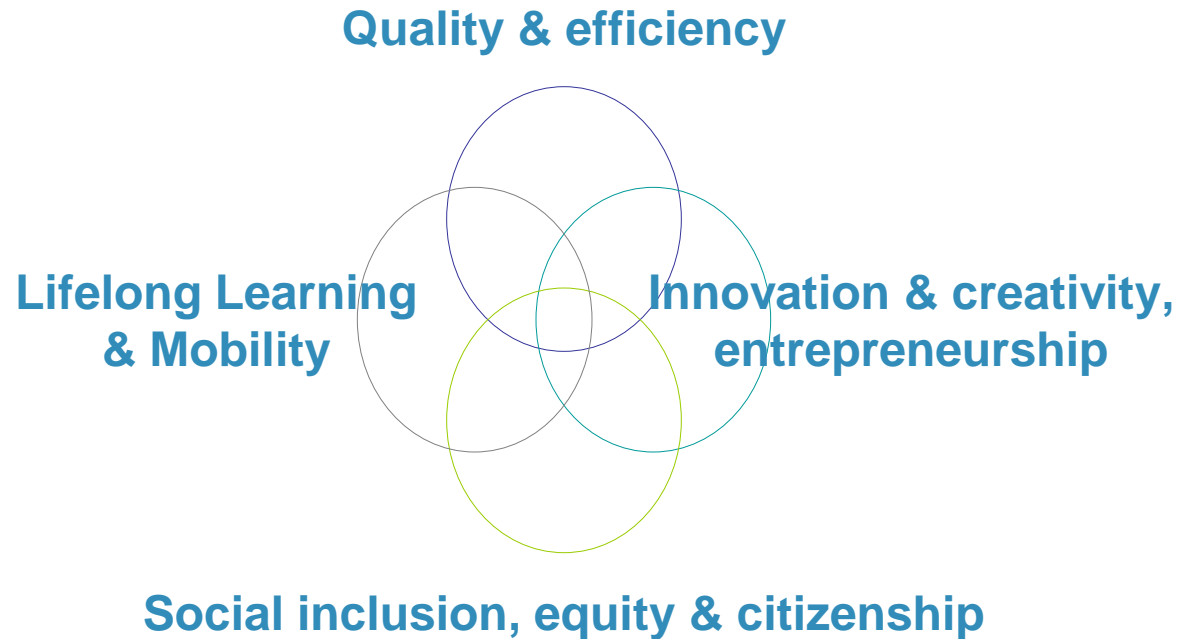
The spirit of the future VET agenda :

- Mobility strategies:
 - regional and local authorities
 - VET providers
